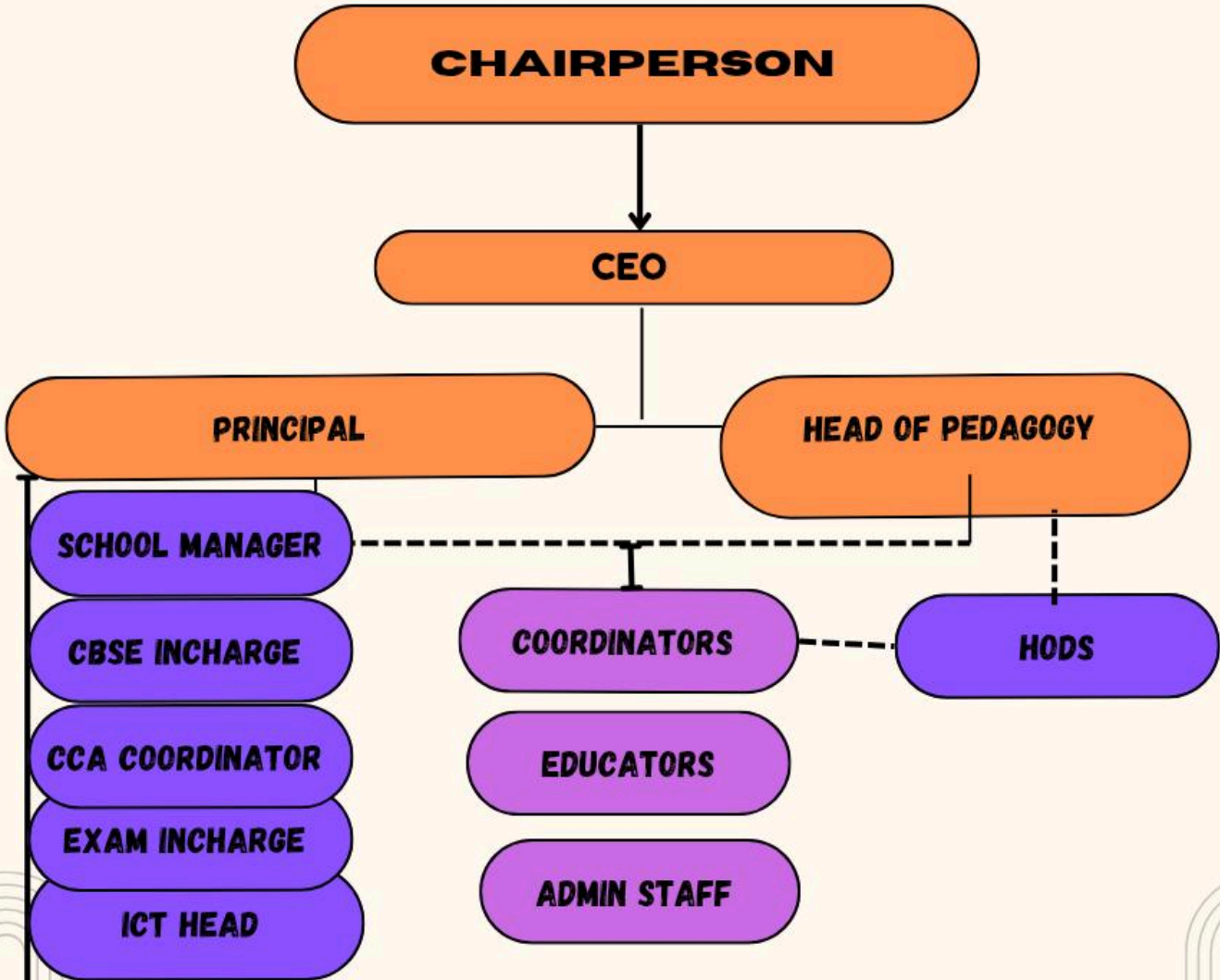

STRUCTURE AND HIERARCHY



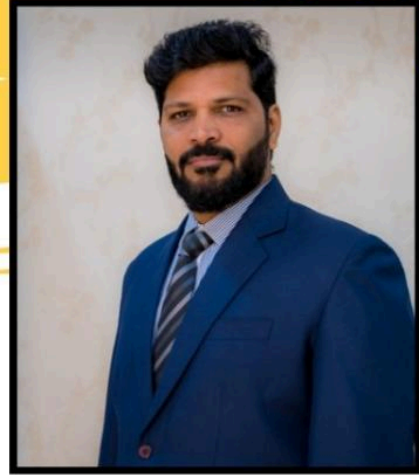

General Rules

Academic Year 2025-26

- 1. School Timings: The school operates from 7:40 AM to 1:40 PM. Students must arrive on time; latecomers may not be allowed without a valid reason.**
- 2. Discipline & Conduct: Students must show respect to teachers, staff, and peers, maintain discipline, and use polite language at all times.**
- 3. Classroom & Corridor Etiquette: Silence must be maintained in classrooms and corridors. Any form of disruption is discouraged.**
- 4. Punctuality & Attendance: Regular attendance is compulsory. Unjustified absences will be recorded and may impact performance.**
- 5. Cleanliness & Hygiene: Keeping the school clean is a shared responsibility. Littering is strictly prohibited, and students must use dustbins.**
- 6. Mobile Phones & Gadgets: The use of mobile phones and electronic gadgets is strictly prohibited inside the school campus. Confiscation will occur if found.**
- 7. Respect for School Property: Students must not damage school property. Any damage caused must be reported immediately, and the student will bear repair costs.**

8. Dress Code & Uniform: Students must wear the prescribed school uniform neatly and properly, ensuring it is clean and ironed.

9. Grooming & Personal Appearance: Boys must keep short, neat hair, and girls with long hair must tie it properly. Makeup, nail polish, and fancy jewellery are not allowed.

10. Footwear: Students must wear black school shoes with white socks. Sports shoes are permitted only on PT days.

11. Homework & Assignments: All assignments, projects, and homework must be completed and submitted on time. Delays may lead to penalties.

12. Examinations & Tests: Attending all tests and exams is mandatory. Unjustified absences can result in serious academic consequences.

13. Co-curricular & Extracurricular Activities: Students are encouraged to actively participate in various activities such as sports, debates, and cultural events.

14. Parental Communication & PTMs: Parents/guardians must check school circulars, notices, and diaries regularly and attend Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTMs).

15. Transport Rules: Students using school transport must follow bus rules. Any misconduct in the bus will result in disciplinary action.
